

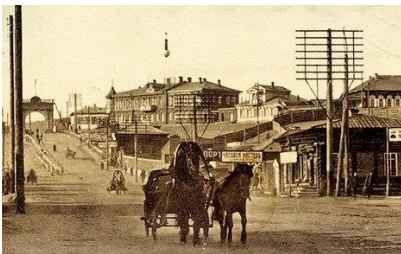
My mother town – Ulan-Ude. From old times to nowadays.
